Swiss Travel Pass included with all holidays

One of the greatest joys of a holiday in Switzerland lies in using the excellent transport system to explore the country at your own pace, with very little fuss.

The holidays in this brochure **all include a Swiss Travel Pass**. As well as covering all the scenic rail journeys connecting your resorts, you will have complete freedom to strike out and explore the wonderful scenery surrounding wherever you are staying. You can hop on a train to visit a nearby town, settle in with a drink on one of the historic lake steamers for a memorable cruise, or board one of the distinctive yellow PostBuses for a ride up into the mountains – all for free. Your Swiss Travel Pass also acts as a discount card for the cable cars and other mountain transport. Take a look at the map on the back of this brochure to see the freedom you have across Switzerland. The mainline railways are shown in red solid lines, PostBuses in yellow and lake cruises in white. The cable cars, mountain railways and funiculars are shown in dotted lines which indicates up to 50% discount.

Benefits of the Swiss Travel Pass

- Free unlimited travel on all mainline trains, lake steamers and PostBuses throughout Switzerland
- Fabulous convenience of not having to visit ticket offices when the travel is free just hop on board!
- Up to 50% off cable cars, mountain railways and funiculars
- Staying in Lucerne? The Mount Rigi train/cable car, Stanserhorn cable car and Stoos funicular are also free, as well as cruises on the full length of the beautiful lakes of Lucerne and Uri

If your budget allows, an upgrade to 1st class is well worth the extra spend. On the trains you benefit from more space and quieter carriages, and on lake boats 1st class is normally on the top deck – with better viewing and fewer fellow passengers.



Museum Pass

Did you know that your Swiss Travel Pass also acts as Museum Pass, giving you free access to over 500 museums and attractions across Switzerland? Just a few popular examples include Chillon Castle in Montreux, Alimentarium in Vevey, Olympic Museum in Lausanne, the castles in Spiez and Thun, Matterhorn Museum in Zermatt, Stockalper Palace in Brig, National Park Centre in Zernez, UNESCO World Heritage castles in Bellinzona, art museums in Interlaken and Lucerne, and of course a long list of museums in the big cities of Zurich, Geneva, Bern and Basel.

Good to know - excursions

Some higher altitude cable cars and mountain railways have operating seasons of **late June-mid October** and **December-March**. Any trips which we state are included in the price of the holiday will be running, but we cannot guarantee exact dates of operations of other trips which are shown merely as recommendations. If there is a particular trip you would like to make during your stay, please do check before confirming your holiday booking.

St. Moritz and Appenzell have a fantastic travel card scheme which is offered free during the summer months (when you stay 1 or 3 nights respectively) and which entitles you to completely free travel on the local cable cars and mountain railways.





With your **Swiss Travel Pass**, Lucerne is perfectly placed to enjoy **free** travel around the dramatic scenery of Central Switzerland - a cruise is a must as this is without doubt one of the most beautiful lakes, whose shoreline is dotted with idyllic villages. Also included free with your Swiss Travel Pass are the famous old cog railway to the stunning peak of Mount Rigi, the Stanserhorn open top deck cable car and the Stoos funicular, and even a trip further afield to historic Bern. Pilatus and other mountain railways and cable cars around Lake Lucerne are available at a 50% reduction.

Day 5. Scenic rail journey on the Treno Gottardo Line to Locarno

Your next adventure is at a leisurely pace on the **Treno Gottardo Line** which takes you around Lake Lucerne via Brunnen and Flüelen then heads up the Reuss valley with ever changing views towards



A true highlight of a holiday to Switzerland is a journey on the Glacier Express, one of the world's most famous scenic routes. Immerse yourself in the outstanding panoramic views and enjoy the three course lunch served at your seat.

The Glacier Express has been running for over 90 years between the Matterhorn village of Zermatt and glamorous St. Moritz. The panoramic trip takes you across the heart of the Swiss Alps, over 291 bridges and through 91 tunnels, winding its way through remote valleys, past sheer rock faces and idyllic mountain villages. Thanks to the large panoramic windows, you have clear views of mountain peaks, deep gorges and UNESCO protected landscapes. Some of the highlights include the Rhine Gorge (the Grand Canyon of Switzerland), the impressive Landwasser Viaduct and the highest point of the journey at the Oberalp Pass: 2,033m above sea level.

You should set aside a day for this remarkable journey - it takes almost 8 hours for the full route between St. Moritz and Zermatt. A shorter journey between Chur and Brig is around $4\frac{1}{2}$ hours.

On board the Glacier Express

The huge panoramic windows extend into the roof so that you can gaze upon the highest peaks as you travel. All carriages were all refurbished in 2021 – they are air conditioned and offer comfortable seating. 1st class carriages have fewer passengers and seats which are slightly bigger. To enhance your enjoyment, English commentary is provided via headphones which you plug into your smartphone. Windows at the carriage entrances can be lowered for mirror-free photography.

Dining on the Glacier Express

Dining is a leisurely experience as the ever changing scenery slowly passes by. Your pre-booked lunch, which is freshly prepared in the galley kitchen, is served at your seat. Further refreshments are available to purchase.

Excellence Class

You'll be greeted on the platform at the private check-in desk and your luggage stowed for you. On board, you'll find that there are only 20 places in the VIP carriage - all of them guaranteed to be window seats - and a dedicated in-carriage bar which provides a welcome drink. Tea and coffee and soft drinks are provided throughout the day, and you have access to a tablet packed with information about the journey. The superb food offering is a highlight, with each passenger being served a seasonal 6 course menu, with accompanying wines. This is a fabulous way to enjoy the journey, perhaps during an anniversary or birthday celebration. Available at a supplement in addition to 1st class prices.

BERNINA EXPRESS

FROM MIGHTY GLACIERS TO SWAYING PALMS



Crossing the Alps from Switzerland to Italy and back again, the Bernina Express is the highest mountain railway in the Alps. This beloved line combines virtuoso engineering skills with glorious surrounding landscapes.

The full journey starts in Chur and features 55 tunnels and 196 bridges. Travel through the Albula Valley, with a looping route between Bergün and Preda and a crossing over the Landwasser Viaduct. After St. Moritz, there are views of the Morteratsch Glacier and Bernina Diavolezza, and you climb to the highest point on the line: 2,253m. The train pauses at Alp Grüm where you can take photos of the beautiful alpine views. A meandering descent features the Lago di Poschiavo and the Brusio viaduct with its 360-degree curve – necessary to overcome the difference in altitude. You'll cross the Italian border and arrive in Tirano, a small town with welcoming restaurants for lunch. If you are travelling onwards to Lugano, the comfortable Bernina Bus takes you through the Italian countryside - past vineyards and picturesque little villages – and along Lake Como before you cross back into Switzerland.

Bernina Express as part of a multi centre holiday

The Bernina Express train and coach journey takes you on the slow, scenic route through the Alps via Italy. It can be used to connect Chur with Lugano (9 hours) or St. Moritz/Pontresina with Lugano (7 hours) and offers comfortable travel with glorious views.

Where a Bernina Express day trip is included in a holiday price, the journey towards Tirano is on a standard regional train and the return is on board a Bernina Express carriage. This can be reversed, or a small supplement paid to upgrade the standard leg.

On board the Bernina Express train

All carriages are air conditioned and very comfortable, while 1st class carriages have slightly bigger seats and fewer passengers. Commentary of the most important sights is provided via the carriage speakers or can be sent to your smartphone. Thanks to the panoramic windows extending into the roof, the mountains soar majestically before your eyes.



Thanks to world-class engineering, passengers no longer need to change trains on this popular journey: the new trains now travel seamlessly through the spectacular scenery. With a popular resort to enjoy at either end, this makes for a wonderful holiday.

On this picturesque route, you'll enjoy views of Lake Thun and the pyramid shaped Mount Niesen as you depart Interlaken. The railway line heads inland after Spiez - into the mountains and through a narrow gorge before the Simmen Valley. From Zweisimmen, the train climbs to its highest point at Saanenmöser and on towards the chic mountain resort of Gstaad. Look out for hot air balloons around Chateau-d'Oex then it's through the valley and the long Jaman Tunnel. At Les Avants, you'll enjoy scenic woodlands and meadows. The dramatically winding descent towards Montreux offers spectacular views of Lake Geneva.

The GoldenPass Express runs four times a day in each direction between Interlaken and Montreux and the journey takes 3 hours 15 minutes.

On board the GoldenPass Express

Panoramic windows extend into the roofspace for amazing views of the beautiful landscape. Being brand new, both the 2nd and 1st class carriages are very comfortable; the latter has bigger seats and more space. For your refreshment, there is an at-seat catering service with drinks and snacks. Breakfast or lunch plates can be pre-ordered.

Prestige Class

Prestige Class offers superbly comfortable seats which are raised 40cm higher against the windows, allowing you to feel as if you are truly in the midst of the scenery through which you are passing. The ingenious seats also rotate to be facing the direction of travel. For an extra touch of luxury, the seats are heated - a real treat in the winter months. Prestige Class passengers can pre-order a caviar and Champagne package.

GoldenPass Belle Epoque

This historic version runs between Zweisimmen and Montreux. The nostalgic, beautifully renovated 1930s carriages offer an opportunity to step back in time and experience travel from a bygone era.

LUZERN-INTERLAKEN EXPRESS

RELAXING JOURNEY THROUGH LAKES & MOUNTAINS SCENERY



This scenic panoramic train connects favourite resorts in a two hour journey through the very heart of Switzerland, passing along the shores of crystal clear lakes and over the magnificent Brünig mountain pass.

Spectacular views of the Swiss Alps will accompany you all the way along this popular route. Board the train with its distinctive red livery in historic Lucerne, and you travel along the lakeside to Alpnachstad where the Pilatus cog railway starts its amazing ascent. You'll travel along the Saarner lake and then for the section from Giswil, the train is required to engage its cog rail system to overcome a gradient four times steeper than the famous Gotthard line.

Another scenic lake (Lungern) comes into view after which you head through picturesque countryside towards the Brünig Pass which - at a height of over 1,000m - links Central Switzerland with the Bernese Oberland. The journey continues to Meiringen, starting point for visits to the region's gorges and mountain lakes as well the thundering Reichenbach Falls, made famous by Sherlock Holmes' watery end. The train descends towards Brienz and here you again travel along a picturesque lakeshore as you make your way to Interlaken. On arrival, look up for lovely views towards the Jungfrau mountains.

On board the Luzern-Interlaken Express

The modern, air conditioned carriages are available in 1st and 2nd class and offer comfortable seating and large panoramic windows, allowing you to fully enjoy the passing scenery. Why not download the train's LiveGuide app which displays a live map and interesting information about where you are on the journey at any given moment.

Bistro car

The train has a bistro car where you can sit and enjoy tea/coffee, soft drinks, beer and a choice of breakfast items, snacks and selected main meals. The baked goods on offer are produced by local bakeries in

Interlaken and Lucerne. Alternatively, a new service means that you can order via an app and have your refreshments brought directly to your seat.

GOTTHARD PANORAMA EXPRESS

HISTORIC BOAT AND TRAIN JOURNEY THROUGH THE ALPS



This is an enchanting journey which combines a tranquil cruise along the length of picturesque Lake Lucerne with a train ride through the heart of the Gotthard mountains and the sunny Ticino region. Travel is in 1st class throughout.

The new 57km Gotthard Base Tunnel whisks you from Lucerne to Lugano under 2 hours. However, we love the historic - and far more scenic - way of travelling between these two resorts! You'll depart Lucerne for almost 3 hours of scenic cruising on the 1st class upper deck of an elegant motor boat or restored paddle steamer. This is one of Switzerland's most beautiful lakes with a shoreline dotted with idyllic villages; the cruise also passes by the historic Rütli meadow, birthplace of the Swiss Confederation in 1291. At Flüelen, you transfer to 1st class panoramic coaches of the Gotthard railway and travel onwards towards the original 15km alpine tunnel which dates from 1882. The looping track also gives amazing views of the landscape, including views from three different angles of the Wassen Church. You'll continue down through the picturesque Ticino region to Lugano.

On board the Gotthard Panorama Express

The boats on Lake Lucerne are a joy, particularly in 1st class which is located on the top deck. Here you will have room to relax and enjoy the stunning lake views as you sip a coffee or a cold beer. The first class dining room is an excellent place to enjoy lunch if you wish, with meals prepared on board in the galley kitchen.

The train is waiting for you in Flüelen. The 1st class carriages are roomy and comfortable, with large panoramic windows to enhance your enjoyment of the views. Information about the historic route is played out and you also have a guide on your train to point out special points of interest. During the journey you can head to the photo coach which has windows that open. There is a selection of snacks and drinks available from the at-seat trolley service.

Gotthard Panorama Express operating dates

The official journey can be enjoyed Tuesday-Sunday from 15 April to 22 October. However, it is still possible to travel on the same route on Mondays, and also during the November-March period. Boats sail across Lake Lucerne all year - albeit with a more limited service in winter - and you may be sailing aboard a comfortable motorboat rather than a steamship. At Flüelen, you can connect with the Treno Gottardo service to Locarno which also runs through the Gotthard mountains via Bellinzona where it is an easy change to the local train for Lugano. This route offers both 1st and 2nd class travel.

Lugano and the Ticino region lie south of the Alps and have the warmest climate in Switzerland. You can therefore enjoy pleasantly mild weather even in spring and autumn.

AROSA LINE

Scenic day trip recommendations

CRUISES ON LAKE THUN & LAKE BRIENZ

These two lakes lie either side of Interlaken, each fed by pure alpine water coming down from the highest glaciers. Criss-crossing the lakes are a number of pleasure cruisers, and spending a couple of hours on board is sure to be one of the highlights of your holiday. The comfortable modern boats have dining facilities and a well-stocked bar. First class tickets allow you to access the upper deck, with fewer passengers and fantastic views. Each lake has a jewel in the crown: a lovingly restored paddlewheel steamer. The Blümlisalp on Lake Thun and the Lötschberg on Lake Brienz are real treasures - look out for 'dampfschiff' on the timetables to indicate when they sail.

The lakes are of course surrounded by fabulous mountain scenery. With a day ticket you can disembark to explore a waterside village or take a mountain railway up to explore the peaks – then simply join a later boat to continue your cruise. A charming feature of Lake Thun is the series of romantic castles, while Lake Brienz boasts the Giessbach waterfall.

GORNERGRAT

The Matterhorn is the iconic symbol of Switzerland and a favourite place from which to view it is the Gornergrat. Take the mountain railway from Zermatt and enjoy the slow journey up to 3,089m altitude. When you reach the Gornergrat summit, you will find a very different world – a rocky landscape, pure mountain air and views over the Alps. Walkers can take the trail to Riffelsee to see the Matterhorn reflected in the lake's waters; other activities include the 'Zoom the Matterhorn' interactive exhibition, and meeting the black-nosed sheep who graze on the alpine grass. Perhaps best of all is relaxing with a drink on the panorama terrace and losing yourself in the scenery.

The Gornergrat railway has been delighting visitors for 125 years! The rail line leads over dramatic bridges, through galleries and tunnels, across forests of larch and Swiss stone pine, and past rocky ravines and mountain lakes. At the summit, the panorama is among the finest in the world, taking in the Gorner Glacier as well as 29 mountains rising to above 4,000m.
